We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for 68-year-old Norman Dalton Denslow, of Newberry Township, to be held accountable for viciously killing his family's cat. It is our understanding that Denslow repeatedly slammed the cat into a bedroom wall, and punched the feline in the head, while his daughter was in the home.

Over 17,424 of our supporters have signed the petition (please see attached for signatures and comments) asking for Denslow to receive the maximum punishment for his charges of felony aggravated cruelty to an animal and a summary offense of disorderly conduct.

It is our understanding that Norman may be in court this week and that there may be a trial in or around November 8th. Will you kindly keep us updated about the status of this important case? We expect to see this man held accountable for the death of this innocent cat. We trust you can/will utilize this petition in the courtroom and we urge you to read some of the comments from supporters as well.
