SUFFOLK COUNTY SPCA CHARGES FORMER BRENTWOOD STUDENT WITH ANIMAL CRUELTY

Detectives from the Suffolk County SPCA charged a Brentwood male on March 3, 2024 with animal cruelty for a brutal, sadistic, and heinous beating of a black cat with a metal bar at Brentwood High School which he and his friends videoed and uploaded to social media.

Roy Gross, Chief of the Suffolk SPCA, said that its detectives charged a former Brentwood High School male student with animal cruelty for the incident after an extensive investigation following an initial complaint in September of 2023, when a complainant who was also a former Brentwood High Shool student at the time, recognized the location of the incident as the school and the 17-year-old male as a student when the video was taken. The male can be seen beating a black cat who was yelping after being struck with the metal bar for no apparent cause, and resulted in severe traumatic injuries to the cat.
