I, Brent W. Johnson 2274, of lawful age, being first duly sworn on oath, depose and state:

Your Affiant is a Detective with the Wichita Police Department (WPD). In that capacity, Affiant was assigned to assist in the follow-up investigation of WPD case number **25C157408**, occurring on or between August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, and **August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, in Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas. During this investigation, Affiant learned the following information:

On **August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 1348 hours, Officer T. Liedl 2694** was dispatched to an assist law enforcement agency call at The Emergency Veterinarian Hospital at **5618 W 21<sup>st</sup> Street Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.**

**Officer Faber #MZ201** with the Maize Kansas Police Department had been called to the Pawsh Veterinarian Clinic at **5255 N Maize Rd Suite 101, Maize, Sedgwick County, Kansas** for an abused cat that had been brought in. Officer Faber told Officer Liedl that **Tammy Wilson (W/F )** brought in her 4-year-old cat **Willow** to the veterinarian with injuries to its tail and anus. The veterinarian said that it appeared like a human had abused the cat and Tammy told the veterinarian she had left her son, **Jacob Wilson (W/M 27)**, alone with Willow the week before and said she thought Jacob was the abuser of the cat. Officer Faber learned, Tammy told the Pawsh Veterinarian staff that Jacob had abused cats in the past. Officer Liedl searched for any prior police reports in which there was any description about abuse of an animal involving Jacob but could not find anything reported to law enforcement. Willow was transferred from the Pawsh Veterinarian Clinic to the Emergency Veterinarian Hospital.

Your Affiant contacted called to The Emergency Veterinarian Hospital to conduct interviews and spoke with **Dr. Kelly Crowdis (W/F )**, the on-duty veterinarian at the Emergency Veterinarian Hospital. Dr. Crowdis said that Willow had the following injuries:

- Large amount of swelling at the base of the tail
- Swelling to the anal sphincter
- Anal dilation
- No anal tone

Dr. Crowdis took swabs from the interior of the anus and was able to see sperm from the swab when it was applied to a microscope slide. Dr. Crowdis said that there was no way to tell visually if the sperm was from a human or an animal. Dr. Crowdis said that there was no doubt in her mind that a human had inflicted the injury to Willow. With the combination of size of the injury to the anus, the amount of injury, and the amount of semen present. Dr. Crowdis said that cats rarely engage in anal sexual activity.

Your Affiant spoke to **Madison Cessna (W/F )**, a veterinarian assistant for The Emergency Veterinarian Hospital. Madison said that she had observed sperm in the microscope from the anal swab. Madison was able to photograph the microscope's image that clearly shows a sperm.

Your Affiant interviewed Tammy Wilson. Tammy said that she cares for around 20 cats. She said around 10 cats live inside the home, including 8 females and 2 males. Tammy said that all female cats inside the house are spayed. Tammy said all the male cats inside the house are neutered. Tammy said that male cats that are fully intact were not allowed to live inside the home, only outside. Tammy thought that they had around 10 cats that lived outside, some of them were feral cats. Tammy said that cats that live outside were never allowed to come inside and the cats that live inside were never allowed outside.

Tammy said that Jacob has a history of violent behavior. Tammy said Jacob has been violent since childhood and had recently been arrested for domestic violence against Tammy and her husband, **Gary Wilson (W/M )**. Tammy said that Jacob went to a therapist years ago, she could not remember the therapist's name, and the therapist told her that Jacob reported that he had raped a cat. Tammy said she was surprised and had no idea when that occurred. Tammy said she locks the indoor cats up in the back southeast bedroom whenever Jacob was alone with them after that day. She said Jacob was not allowed near the cats without supervision. Tammy said she and

Gary believe Jacob killed a bird that she was nursing back to health in a cage years ago. Recently, Tammy said she was in the bathroom and heard Jacob walk into the cat's bedroom. She quickly got out of the bathroom and found Jacob in the bedroom with his hand raised as if he were about to hit one of the cats. Jacob said he was trying to kill a spider that was near the cat.

Tammy said last week on possibly Wednesday **August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, she couldn't remember the exact date, she and Gary left the house to go to Walmart. Tammy said, while they were out, she realized that they had left the cats' bedroom door unlocked and Jacob was left alone with the cats. Tammy said they hurried home. Tammy said no one else has been in the home since Jacob moved in a few weeks ago. Tammy said only Gary, Jacob, and she live in the house.

Tammy said that she found Willow on **August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025**, laying on a blanket in the cat's bedroom, the bedroom on the southeast of the home, located in Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas. She said this blanket was a quilt style that they kept over an air vent. She described the blanket as white on the back and red, white, and blue on the front. Tammy noticed there was a small amount of brown discharge on the blanket. On **August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, she noticed Willow in the same location on the same blanket and there was more brown discharge on the blanket. Tammy said that it was unusual for Willow to lay on this blanket and in this location, Willow normally stays in her "cat apartment" sleeping area in the cat's bedroom. Tammy said that she decided to take Willow to the veterinarian. Tammy said when the veterinarian told her about the injuries to Willow, she immediately believed that Jacob had done something to Willow.

Your Affiant spoke to Gary Wilson. Gary said that Tammy usually stays at home with Jacob, while he is at work, so she can keep an eye on him. Gary said that Jacob is never left with the cats unsupervised. Gary said the female cats specifically stay away from Jacob. Gary also said that they had no un-neutered male cats in the house. Gary said only Jacob, Tammy, and he have been in the house since their daughter moved out years ago.

Gary said he and Tammy left for Walmart on Friday **August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025**, at 1534 hours Gary was able to confirm this with the call log on his phone. He realized that they had left Jacob alone with the cats and the room was unlocked. Gary called Jacob at 1641 hours and told him that they would be coming home soon and asked if he wanted McDonalds. Gary said they got to McDonalds, and the drive-thru line was long, so they immediately came home. Gary said they got home at 1702 hours and had tacos at home instead.

Gary said today that Tammy found Willow with pain in her hind quarters. Gary said he had noticed that Willow normally stays in her "cat apartment" in the southeast bedroom but recently would lay on the blanket on the floor and stare at the wall. Gary said the last time he saw Willow was on Saturday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.

Your Affiant interviewed Jacob in a post-Miranda interview. Jacob said he got along with the cats. He said he was close to a cat named Rose and Rose died years before.

Jacob said that he and Willow used to be close. Jacob said Willow has been scared of him ever since he got arrested for domestic violence.


Jacob said on Friday August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, when his parents left for Walmart, he was playing video games. Jacob said he has not been near Willow. Jacob said he had no idea why Willow would have any injury and had no idea why Willow would have semen in her anus. Jacob said he did not do any injury to Willow's anus. Jacob said the semen located inside Willow would not be his. Jacob said that only he, Tammy, and Gary have been in the house recently. No one else comes over. Jacob said when he was younger, he "dry humped a cat." From your Affiant's experience, that act can be described as someone rubbing their genitalia on something in a sexual motion, typically for sexual gratification. During the interview, Jacob made the statement, that was why police were talking to him about the incident with Willow. Your Affiant asked Jacob about prior sexual experiences, Jacob said the only sexual experiences he has had were with himself and only in his bedroom or the bathroom. Jacob said he has never been in the southeast cat's room doing anything sexual. Jacob consented to a forensic exam.
