

In 2020, Ohlson was charged with a felony for allegedly torturing a kitten in Reno, Nevada.

The Biggest Little Cat Rescue reported that he adopted two kittens, Haven and Nola, through a PetSmart adoption event on July 8. Days later, Haven was discovered abandoned inside his carrier in a dumpster near Ohlson's Reno residence.

Washoe County Regional Animal Services confirmed Ohlson was charged in 2020 after allegedly torturing a kitten inside a vehicle in a Walmart parking lot. An incident officials say was captured on video. Ohlson pleaded guilty to attempting to kill or torture a kitten at the Reno Walmart.

He received a suspended sentence of 19 to 48 months in exchange for completing adult drug court. Despite failing multiple drug tests, he was found compliant by judges Kathleen Drakulich and Tammy Riggs, discharged from probation, and released in November 2022.
