Subject: Opposition to Parole for Jason Brown, Inmate ID 1147705

To the Nevada Board of Parole Commissioners:

I am writing to respectfully urge the Board to deny parole for Jason Brown. He was convicted for the extreme, deliberate, and prolonged acts of cruelty that led to the deaths of seven dogs in Reno. The killings were sadistic in nature and reveal a profound disregard for life.

Although Nevada strengthened its animal cruelty laws in 2023, those changes cannot be applied retroactively because Brown committed these crimes in 2014. As a result, he remains eligible for parole under the law that existed at the time. Regardless of his legal eligibility, the nature of Brown's actions demonstrates a pattern of behavior that continues to raise serious concerns about public safety and respect for life.

I recognize and respect the Board's responsibility to evaluate each case carefully and fairly. I ask that you consider the extraordinary brutality of Brown's crimes, the lasting trauma inflicted on the victims' families and the community, and his prior parole denials when making your decision.

For these reasons, I strongly oppose parole and respectfully request that Jason Brown remain incarcerated for the full duration of the sentence imposed by the Court.
