Subject: Opposition to Parole for Jason Brown, Inmate ID 1147705

To the Nevada Board of Parole Commissioners,

I am writing to respectfully urge the Board to **deny parole for Jason Brown**. He was convicted for the extreme, deliberate, and prolonged acts of cruelty that led to the deaths of seven dogs in Reno. The killings were sadistic in nature and reveal his profound disregard for life.

Although Nevada law classifies these offenses as “non-violent,” the nature of Brown’s actions clearly reflects a pattern of behavior that poses a continued risk to the community. The severity of this case has deeply affected residents both within Nevada and across the country, and many of us remain concerned about the danger he would pose if released.

I recognize and respect the Board’s responsibility to evaluate each case carefully and fairly. I ask that you consider the gravity of Brown’s actions, the lasting trauma inflicted on the community, and his prior parole denials when making your decision.

For these reasons, I strongly oppose parole and respectfully request that Jason Brown remain incarcerated for the full duration of his sentence.
