

**Subject: Demand for a Full Investigation and Mental Health
Intervention in Animal Cruelty Case**

Dear Chief of Police, Officer Cameron Gilroy, and Members of the Loveland Police Department,

I am writing as a deeply concerned citizen to respectfully request a full review of the investigation into the reported brutal attacks on multiple neighborhood cats in Loveland. The allegations described in this case are deeply disturbing and involve repeated acts of extreme animal cruelty that deserve a thorough, transparent, and complete investigation.

According to the information made public, witnesses came forward, physical evidence was collected, and the matter reportedly involved discussions among students that were serious enough to prompt school counselors and the principal to contact law enforcement. These allegations warrant careful attention— not only to seek accountability where appropriate, but also to ensure the safety of both animals and the community. Research has consistently demonstrated a link between severe, intentional animal cruelty and an increased risk of future violence toward people.

For that reason, I respectfully urge the Loveland Police Department to ensure this case receives the attention it deserves and to work with the appropriate agencies, including Child Protective Services, to determine whether the accused child requires a comprehensive psychological evaluation and appropriate mental health intervention. Early intervention can protect both the child and the community.

Neighborhood residents deserve to feel safe allowing their pets outdoors without fear of horrific abuse. Equally important, a child accused of such disturbing acts should not simply be ignored if there is an opportunity for meaningful evaluation and treatment. Please ensure this matter receives a full review and that every appropriate investigative and protective resource is utilized.
